The meeting was called to order by Ketra.

Account balance \$1,729.64 with a deposit of \$489.00 (Tuesday's concessions & T-shirt sales) not reflected. At registration the Booster Club made apx. \$600.00 (\$100.00 was used as start up money for concessions)

Requests:

Ms. Weech is requesting again this year funds for the Person of Character lunch (POC lunch).

Last year \$200 was given.

The Booster Club agreed to fund this at \$200.00.

Ms. Helderman (home living teacher) is requesting money for fabric for students who cannot afford to purchase it for the class. She is estimating the amount to be \$300.00.

The Booster Club agreed to fund this at \$300.00.

Mr. Thompson presented the following requests

\$680.00 for the motivational video that is done with music on 3 screens for the all the students to watch around Christmas. He said the price was less because Churchill signed up for the same video.

The Booster Club agreed to fund this at \$680.00.

\$100.00 for the 8th graders to go to Springfield this money would be in addition to funds from a grant. The money would pay for 20 adults to chaperone.

\$150-\$200 for 2 tents to be used for the people taking tickets at games.

The Booster Club agreed to fund this and it was decided that the 2 tents needed to be purchased this weekend.

Ketra mentioned that the club has a bill coming in from Concession Specialist and G & M.

Ketra, Kelly and Becca agreed that the club should pay all expenses directly to the vendors.

Kelly is going to check with the schools finance department regarding Ms. Weech's POC lunch on whom to make the check payable to.

Ketra said the new concession stand by the football field is great and is much appreciated.

The schools website is to be up and running on September 24, 2009, and that there will be a link for the Booster Club. Becca said she would type up the minutes and post them on a blog.

Ketra suggested that we have a sprit wear week sale before Christmas so that parents could bring money into the office to buy sprit wear as gifts. Suggested items that could be sold are T-shirts and pj bottoms.

Ketra is going to talk to Lori at Go Van Gogh's regarding a possible new design on T-shirts.

Gold cards – sales will start on Monday, November 2, 2009

The club needs to get with merchants to be on the card.

It was suggested that we send out a note first asking parents if they want to sell them or not and state that they will be responsible for paying \$25.00 or returning the cards.

The next Booster Club meeting will be Thursday, October 8, 2009 at 6:30 p.m. in the library.
